Pay Your Center Club Bills Online!

You are now able to set up online bill pay through our new website under your member log-in. We have options to pay your monthly balances by credit card, debit card, and EFT/ACH (checking account).

We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.

Online Bill Pay Options & Set-up

There are many options to pay your Center Club bill:

- **Online bill pay** (with credit card, debit card and ACH (checking account) options)
 - **One-time payments** (to be paid on or before the last day of the month)
 - **Automatic payments** to be paid on the 15th of each month
- **Pay by check**
- **Pay by credit card** (The accounting team processes for you on the 15th of each month)

To pay by mobile app, you MUST already have a credit card or payment option in the system. Due to security issues you cannot add a new card or payment option on the app, only on the Member Website.

Please Note

- **For the initial set up and payment for the online payments**

For your July payment only: If you are choosing to do online bill payment; all payments must be set up and paid by July 26th. If you do not make your online payment by that date, and you have a credit card on file—the Club will process your card between July 27-31st.

After July and going forward: If you set up for automatic credit card payments—your card will be charged on the 15th of the month starting on August 15th. If you plan to make one-time online payments your payment is due on or before the last day of the month.

- **For members with S accounts:** There is a \$50 annual fee to use the S account. This \$50 fee is waived if you make your monthly payments using the online bill pay option through our new website. If you choose to pay by check, or for us to do your credit card processing the \$50 fee applies.

TO SET UP ONLINE BILL PAY

You MUST set up accounts through the website

- Log-in to your member account with your member number and password
- Visit the Pay Bills page found on the member dashboard
- Create your new Payment Options and fill in the required payment information. Set up autopay and never worry about missing a payment again!

Reservations—Members are encouraged to make a reservation for the Main Dining Room or Club events prior to arriving at the Club. By providing the Club with advance notice, we can confirm your reservation and better serve you. Please call Reception at 410-727-7788 or visit www.centerclub.org/members/events to make a reservation.

Cancellation Policy—Cancellations for Club events must be received no less than 48 hours prior to the event, or unless otherwise noted, to avoid any charges. Members who cancel after this period are subject to 50% of fees. Members who do not cancel are charged 100% of fees.

Unaccompanied Guest Policy—Members can extend a Guest Card to a friend or colleague which allows them to use the Club unaccompanied. You are able to provide a Guest Card to 2 different people up to 2 times per year with no one unaccompanied guest being able to use the Club more than 2 times a year. Reservations must be made with Reception at least 48 hours in advance.

Dress Code—Jackets are recommended at lunch and dinner in the Main Dining Room. The Center Club's Business Casual dress code (collared shirt, slacks) is appropriate in all other areas all year long. In addition, dress denim (non-distressed dark denim with no visible rips, tears, holes or frayed edges) worn with a jacket is allowed throughout the Club and on the Light Street side of the Main Dining Room. The Pratt Street side of the Main Dining Room will be reserved for more formally dressed patrons as deemed appropriate by the General Manager. Comparable attire is required for women.
